1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 11.10.2023 passed in CWP-9832-2022.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Siddharth Dahiya, Estate Officer, HSVP, Faridabad, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 11.10.2023 passed in CWP-9832-2022 has been complied with and requisite amount alongwith interest has been refunded to the petitioner, as would decipher from the receipt dated 28.07.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
