1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0012 dated 01.02.2024 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 511 and 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.
2. Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, on instructions from ASI Rajnish Kumar, has submitted that on the last date of hearing, it had been submitted that though there was one other criminal case registered against the petitioner, however, he was on bail in the said case, which fact was in fact incorrect. He submits that the petitioner’s petition for bail in the other criminal case,

wherein identical allegations have been levelled against him, already stood dismissed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, in the circumstances, prays for withdrawal of the instant petition as he had not received the correct instructions on the last date of hearing.
