1. On 08.05.2024, the following order was passed by this
Court:-

“The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, by the present petitioners, seeking mandamus upon the official respondents no.2 to 3, to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents no.5 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner no.1, who is a married man, has solemnized marriage with petitioner no.2, whose marital status was 'unmarried' at the time of the instant marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners belongs to Muslim religion, and as per mohammedan law petitioner no.1 can perform second marriage during the existence of first marriage.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Bhupender Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3-State and waives service.

Notice upon respondents no. 4 to 6, be issued, on furnishing the requisite process fee by the petitioners, returnable within three weeks.

Adjourned to 03.07.2024.

The State is directed to file a specific reply whether there is any threat perception exists as set up in the instant petition. ”

2. In deference to the aforesaid order, a status report, dated 28.06.2024, by way of an affidavit of Sh.Ajaib Singh, DSP (HQ), Nuh, has been filed, by the learned State counsel today in Court, which is taken on record.

3. A perusal of the reply reflects that both the petitioners specifically suffered a statement that they do have any apprehension to their life and liberty.

4. In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the instant petition, and the same is ordered to be closed.

5. **Disposed of**, accordingly.
