The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner has solemnized marriage with respondent No.4 on 30.08.2009 and out of this wedlock, two male children were born. He further submits that after their marriage, husband of petitioner i.e. respondent No.4 started beating her and in-laws of the petitioner maltreated her. It is further contended that the petitioner remained silent just to save her matrimonial home in the hope that over the efflux of time, the behaviour of her husband and in-laws will get better but despite her best efforts, nothing has changed, on account of which, the petitioner decided to leave her matrimonial house.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would

be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 09.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 09.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
