The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.88 dated 18.03.2024 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) registered at P.S. Derra Bassi, District SAS Nagar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 19.04.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 19.04.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 19.04.2024 is made absolute.



However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
