Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to respondent No. 2-the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, to consider and decide the representation dated 11.04.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Heard.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioners have no concern with the instant FIR registered against Sagar as one of the accused, who happens to be the son of petitioners No. 1 and 2 and grand son of petitioner No. 3 but despite that the local police is harassing the petitioners by raiding their premises and also calling them on telephone. He further contends that in this regard the petitioners had moved a representation dated 11.04.2024 (Annexure P-2), but no action has been taken thereon.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-2) will be considered and disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with the law by the concerned authority.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 11.04.2024 (Annexure P-2), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners.

9. Disposed of.
