MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU. J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.134 dated 30.05.2015 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 302 and 147 read with Section 149 IPC, at Police Station, Narwana City, District Jind.

2. Status report dated 08.05.2024 by way of affidavit of Sh. Amit Bhatia, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narwana, District Jind filed on behalf of respondent-State is taken on record. Copy supplied to the other side. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. Petitioner along with co-accused formed an unlawful assembly and in prosecution of common object of said assembly caused death of Rattan and caused injuries to Khetia son of Rattan. The accused caused injuries to the parents of Rattan as well.

4. Learned counsel contends that there is no specific role attributed to the petitioner and he is in custody since 09.12.2022. Also contends that trial is likely to take sufficient long time; hence petitioner be released on bail.

5. *Per contra*, learned State counsel while opposing the prayer submits that petitioner has been named in the FIR and his role is specifically mentioned in the initial version. Apart that, petitioner is facing 05 other criminal cases; hence, in case released on bail, he is likely to hamper the trial.
6. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.
7. There is no quarrel that in the initial version, name of the petitioner is specifically mentioned. It is not in dispute that petitioner has been charged by learned trial Court under Section 302 IPC along with other ancillary offences and prosecution evidence is going on. As on today, petitioner is facing 05 other criminal cases and details of which are as under:-

- Thus, in such a scenario, releasing the petitioner on bail will hamper the trial.
8. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present petition, at this stage.
9. Consequently, there is no option, except to dismiss the petition.
