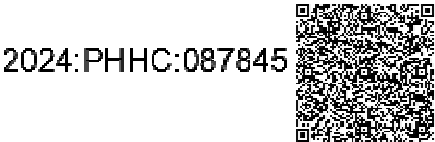

RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the land of the petitioner i.e. Khewat No.75, Khasra No.23//24, situated in the Revenue Estate of Village Lerhroda, District Mohindergarh as prime khasra of land as it is situated within 2 Kms of main road and to grant the compensation.
2. No ground to interfere with the proceedings pending before the competent court below.
3. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
