MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.2 dated 04.01.2024 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 120-B of the IPC (Sections 307, 379-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 19.04.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation.

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia
submits that the injury attributed to the petitioner is
simple in nature.*



Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Narinder is not in a position to dispute the aforementioned factual position.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.04.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Narinder Kumar, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 19.04.2024 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to him, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to him.
