Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.53 dated 24.03.2015 under Sections 498-A, 494, 420, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 28.04.2015 (Annexure P-2).

Learned State counsel, at the very outset, refers to copy of the order dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure R-1) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Zira, filed with the reply to the application i.e. CRM-31163-2021 by way of affidavit of Sandeep Singh Mand, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira, District Hoshiarpur, on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2, to contend that the investigating agency has concluded the investigation and submitted the cancellation report, which has been accepted vide order dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure R-1). As such, nothing survives in the present petition and the same may be disposed of.
