The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a prayer to issue directions to the official respondents to fairly investigate the FIR No.14 dated 25.01.2022, registered under Sections 325, 341, 323, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda.
2. A short reply by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Rural), District Bathinda has been filed on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3 and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel submits that after the registration of the FIR, co-accused namely Harjass Singh @ Jassa has been arrested in the present case and the present petitioner is yet to be arrested by the police. He further contends that after completion of the investigation, final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented against co-accused namely Harjass Singh @ Jassa and the case shall be investigated fairly and impartially.

4. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.
5. Needless to observe that the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail his alternative remedies, if any, available to him in accordance with law.
