1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the charge-sheet (Annexure P-1), enquiry report (Annexure P-4), show cause notice dated 08.08.2002 (Annexure P-4) and order of penalty dated 21.01.2003 (Annexure P-9).
2. Since there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner, notice was issued to the petitioner for today i.e. 26.11.2024.
3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report that the petitioner had died long ago.
4. Neither any legal representative of the petitioner has been brought on record nor anyone else has put in appearance to pursue the instant case.

5. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the legal representatives of the petitioner to revive the same, in case any cause of action still survives.
