RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 13.05.2019 passed in CWP-13650-2014.
2. Reply on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4 by way of affidavit of S. Kashmir Singh, Principal, Mata Gujri College, Fatehgarh Sahib, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Reply by way of affidavit of Kamna Gupta, Deputy Director, Office of Directorate of Higher Education Punjab, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
4. Learned State counsel has submitted that payment of arrears alongwith interest @ 15% per annum has already been made to the petitioner, as would decipher from the grant-in-aid bill (Annexure R-2).

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
