PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.936 dated 25.11.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379A and 34 of IPC at Police Station Suraj Kund, District Faridabad.
2. As per the contents of the FIR, it has been alleged as under:-

“To, Incharge, Police Post Ankhir, Faridabad, it is requested that I (Seema Nagar w/o Sh. Arvind Kumar, am the resident of Add- 644, Top Floor), Sector 21C, Faridabad). Today on 25.11.2023, I was coming from Market of Sector 21C, when I reached at T- Point of House No.310, then from the behind two bike riders name and address not known came and ran after snatching the purse from my hand.

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Some important documents were lying in the purse, which are as follows: 1. Aadhar Card No.819000612819, 2. Votar ID-DKY1027028, 3. Pancard No.ADBPN9290R, 4. Driving License-DL-00320110247980, 5. Metro Card-2 No,6. Cash Rs.4000/-. FIR regarding snatching be registered against the unknown person and my documents be traced out. Time of the occurrence was 19:22 hrs. Sd/- Seema Nagar 9650665466.”

- 3. Petitioner was nominated on the basis of disclosure made by co-accused and further case of the prosecution is that Rs.600 i.e. proceeds in the crime was recovered from the accused. Petitioner is behind bars for 02 months and 13 days.
- 4. Keeping in view the nature of the allegation and the nature of evidence against the petitioner, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
- 5. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
