The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondent – Board to give appointment to the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk as he is fully eligible for the said post on the basis of eligiblity criteria for Lower Division Clerk.

As per the office report, letter issued to Sh. Amit Aggarwal, Advocate, learned counsel for the petitioner has been delivered.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that as a matter of fact the petitioner is working as Sub-Station Attendant at Operation Circle, Bathinda and his case is pending consideration for promotion to the post of Upper Division Clerk, for which the departmental test is required to be cleared.



Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive this petition in case any cause still survives.
