1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing Annexures P-2 to P-4.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the present matter pertains to year 1999 and the petitioner has already compulsorily retired and thus, the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. As per report of the registry, counsel for the petitioner has been informed but none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.
