SURINDER KAUR AND ORS V/S PARMINDER SINGH @ KALA AND ORS.

On 06.05.2024, on behalf of the appellants statement (separately recorded), was made by learned counsel for the appellants to accept Rs.20,20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs Twenty Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the MACT concerned, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect.

Accordingly, Rs.20,20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs Twenty Thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT. On 06.05.2023, Surinder Kaur, appellant No.1 had given a statement before this Forum that Harbhajan Kaur-claimant-appellant No.3 (mother-in-law of appellant No.1) has since expired on 03.10.2010 and there are no other legal heirs except the remaining appellants. Therefore, name of Harbhajan Kaur-appellant No.3 be deleted from the array of parties. The death certificate of deceased and the amended memo of parties have now been placed on record.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.20,20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs Twenty Thousand only) in the name of the appellant No.1-Surinder Kaur with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 10.09.2024 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
