Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to permanently disconnect the connection running in the name of respondent No.3-Karnail Singh son of Surain Singh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents contends that a civil suit No.184/2022 had been instituted by respondent No.3 against the Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd on 24.05.2022 wherein the respondent-Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd had been directed to restore the Tubewell connection of respondent No.3. It is averred that since the Civil Court is already seized of the matter and an interim order has been passed in favour of respondent No.3, it is not possible for respondents No.1 and 2 to permanently disconnect the connection running in the name of



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respondent No.3. They contend that the petitioner may, if so advised, take all his pleas before the Civil Court in the pending Civil Suit that had been instituted much before initiation of the present writ petition.

In view of the aforesaid statement as also the orders of the Civil Court appended with the reply filed on behalf of respondent No.3, the present writ petition is **disposed of** as not pressed at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to take all his pleas before the Civil Court, if so advised.
