1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for quashing of FIR bearing No.452, dated 14.11.2021 (Annexure P-8), under Section 420 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sirsa, which has already been quashed *qua* co-accused Balram Garg, vide order dated 08.04.2022 in CRM-M-49311-2021(Annexure P9), and all the other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. In pursuance of the last order dated 29.05.2024, a status report, dated 03.08.2024, by way of an affidavit of Sh.Subhash Chand, DSP, HQ, Sirsa, has been filed, by the learned State counsel today in Court, which is taken on record, with a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. A study survey of the status report (*supra*), reflects that in the instant FIR, a cancellation report has already been prepared and the same has been submitted before the court concerned.
4. In view of the above supervening events, the instant petition is ordered be **dismissed as having been rendered infructuous**.
