AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to submit final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.0107 dated 10.08.2022, under Sections 294, 506, 34 of IPC and Sections 3, 4 of SC and ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel representing State has filed status report, which is taken on record. As per the status report, cancellation report has been accepted and it is further mentioned that complainant can avail appropriate remedy as per law.
3. In view of the status report, learned counsel for petitioner stated that he does not want to pursue present petition and withdraws the same with liberty to seek appropriate remedy as per law.
4. In view of the statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
