1. The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioners seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice/representation dated 15.03.2024 within a stipulated period in view of the law settled by this Court in CWP-19487-2014 and LPA-87-2015.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that with regard to his grievance, a legal notice/representation dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) has been sent by the petitioners and that despite a lapse of more than 01 month since the date of the aforesaid representation/legal notice no decision has been taken thereupon. He further contends that he would be satisfied in case the respondent-authorities are directed to look into the aforesaid representation/legal notice and the grievance espoused by the petitioners therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Vivek Saini, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.
5. The present petition is accordingly **disposed of** without commenting on the merits of the present case and with a direction to respondent No.2-Sub-Registrar, Gurugram, District Gurugram, to take note of the legal notice/representation dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) served by the petitioners and the same shall be decided expeditiously and preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, after granting an effective opportunity of hearing to the respective parties, in accordance with law.
