Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the order dated 12.11.2020 (Annexure P-6) vide which recovery of Rs.1,86,898/- has been ordered to be effected from the salary of the petitioner and further recovery of salary has been made by giving tabulation vide order dated 09.05.2022 (Annexure P-9) and further the orders dated 09.07.2015 and 23.07.2012 (Annexures P-3 and P-4), be sustained vide which increment of 16 and 32 yearly has been given to the petitioner in view of the Policy dated 03.11.2006 (Annexure P-11). Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to affix and pay the four yearly increment of the petitioner as Inspector since September, 2019.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to serve a justice demand notice upon the competent authority i.e. respondent No.5, within a period of one month from today.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

If any such justice demand notice is served by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided by respondent No.3, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of said notice. The necessary benefits, if found due, shall also be released to the petitioner within a period of three weeks thereafter.
