RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 08.02.2013 passed in CWP-2802-2003 and order dated 10.12.2023 passed in LPA-962-2013.
2. Mr. Varun Suman, Advocate and Mr. Gopal Sharma, Advocate, put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent Nos.3 and 4 has submitted that the service of the petitioner has already been regularized w.e.f. 23.01.2001, pursuant to the orders of the Writ Court. Not only that, even the consequential benefits except the monitory benefits have already been granted to the petitioner from the date of regularization.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
5. Dismissed.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
