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The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the official respondents to take appropriate legal action on the application/representation filed by the petitioner dated 05.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) wherein, it has been clearly mentioned that the private respondents No.7 to 9 along with other unknown persons had not only sexually harassed but has also given severe beatings to the petitioner and her friends Heena and Gurwinder despite which the official respondents No.4 to 6 have failed in their duty to register a case.

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the grievance raised in the present petition has been substantially redressed. The Investigating Agency has already registered FIR on the version given by the petitioner.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
