Prayer in the present writ petition is for seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2-the Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh, to conclude the enquiry pertaining to the allegations of medical negligence in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1, 2 and 4 at this stage,
Mr. Sumeet Jain, Addl. Standing Counsel with Ms. Aashna Gill, Panel Counsel, accept notice on behalf of aforesaid respondents. They inform that the Institute is in the process of concluding the enquiry into the allegations levelled and the documents have been sought from the complainant petitioner herein and that in the event of the documents being furnished within a period of 01 week, the enquiry into the allegations levelled by the petitioner shall be completed within a period of 03 weeks thereafter.

In view of aforesaid statement made on behalf of the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the instant petition at this stage and the same may be disposed of accordingly.

Disposed of as not pressed at this stage.

The respondents shall, however, remain bound by the statement to enquire into the allegations as stated on the complaint being furnished by the petitioner within a period of 01 week.
