Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the impugned attachment order dated 30.05.1984 (Annexure P-1) and entries from the revenue record as sole purpose of the above said order vide which the property of the petitioner is attached has been defeated. Further prayer has been made to direct the official respondents to correct the revenue record by removing the rapat No.301 dated 30.05.1984 from the revenue record and note of attachment of the land measuring 33 kanals 3 marlas as mentioned in the petition, as the sole purpose of the above said attachment order has been defeated and to decide the representation dated 15.03.2024.

On oral request made by counsel for the petitioners Assistant Collector IInd Grade-cum-Tehsildar Dabwali, District Sirsa is impleaded as respondent No.5. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to file amended memo of parties during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that for the redressal of the grievance of the petitioners, they have already filed a representation dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-6) before respondent No.2 but no action has been taken on the same till date.

Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasna Dhawan, AAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and has stated that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioners should file a fresh representation before the Tehsildar, Dabwali newly added respondent and he would decide the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners be granted liberty to file a fresh representation before respondent No.5 i.e. the Assistant Collector IInd Grade-cum-Tehsildar, Dabwali District Sirsa and he be directed to decide the same after hearing the petitioners in a time bound manner.

After hearing both the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file their appropriate representation before respondent No.5 as prayed for within a period of one week from today. If any such representation is filed by the petitioners within the stipulated period, then respondent No.5 i.e. the Assistant Collector IInd Grade-cum-Tehsildar Dabwali District Sirsa is directed to hear the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of its filing.
