HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. By this common order, two writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as both the petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the petitioner(s) have already worked upto the age of 60 years but the only grievance which remains that for certain period, their salary has not been paid which the respondents should be directed to release.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in case salary for any period has not been released to the petitioner(s) and the petitioner(s) raise the said grievance by way of representation, the same will be ascertained keeping in view the record maintained by the Department and in case, it is found feasible that the petitioner(s) are entitled for salary for a particular period, the same will be released to them otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner(s).

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner(s) to approach the respondents by way of representation.

5. Ordered accordingly.
