1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 04.03.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-4273-2022.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Status/compliance report on behalf of respondent No.3 filed in the Registry is taken on record. Learned State counsel submits that order dated 04.03.2022 passed in CWP-4273-2022 has been complied with and claim of the petitioner has been decided and representation filed by the petitioner stands disposed of, vide order dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure R-1).
