This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for placing on
record representation to join the vigilance inquiry as Annexure P-10.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed
and accompanied document (Annexure P-10) is taken on record subject to
just exceptions.

Main case.

1. Petitioner Gurdhir Singh filed petition under Section 482 of
Cr.P.C. for directing respondent No.2 to stop holding multiple inquiries on
the same complaint with further prayer that during the pendency of this
petition respondents be restrained from holding enquiry in the matter in
controversy as per instructions issued by DGP, Punjab (respondent No.2)
or any other direction which the Court may deem fit.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that father of petitioner was working as Chowkidar in the office of Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar who died in road accident on 08.06.2006. On the application filed by mother of the petitioner, present petitioner was granted job on compassionate ground. He was matriculate and was appointed as Peon on 26.06.2007 and started working as Class-IV in the office of SDM-

1. Some inimical person started filing complaint against him that he was appointed on the basis of fake papers. Time and again, multiple complaints were filed levelling similar allegations. Ultimately, petitioner filed present petition.

3. Status report was called for in the case in hand. Status reports dated 08.02.2016, 04.07.2016, 11.07.2016, 19.09.2016, short reply dated 22.03.2017 and status report dated 12.12.2023 have been filed. As per the status reports, referred above, matter was under investigation and no final conclusion was arrived at. In the meantime, petitioner again filed another representation dated 07.09.2023 (Annexure P-10) regarding which Deputy Superintendent of Police, Vigilance Bureau, Unit Amritsar filed status report seeking three month's time for holding enquiry on the representation dated 07.09.2023 received in their office.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that in terms of status report dated 20.09.2024 present petition may be disposed of.

5. Considering the status report, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Vigilance Bureau), Unit Amritsar is directed to hold proper enquiry and dispose of the representation regarding matter in controversy, within a period of three months.

6. With these directions, petition is disposed of accordingly.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
