1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that she competed for the post of Laboratory Technician to be filled in the ESI Healthcare, Haryana and got selected but the respondents are not allowing the petitioner to join on the post in question.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was selected for the post in question and her name was recommended for appointment against one of the advertised post but though, the other recommended candidates have already been given appointment but the petitioner is not being considered for appointment and that too without any valid justification, hence, the respondents be directed to grant the petitioner appointment with effect from the date the similarly situated candidates have been appointed to the post in question along with all the consequential benefits including arrears of salary.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 09.04.2024 (Annexure P-12) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 09.04.2024 (Annexure P-12) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of three weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
