Mr. Tej Bahadur, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the appellants and states that he has already filed his power of attorney in the registry. A scanned copy thereof has been taken out and placed on record.

As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.5,75,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.3-Jitender Singh S/o Prem Singh, for & on behalf of all the claimants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a cheque in the sum of Rs.5,75,000/- favouring appellant No.3-Jitender Singh S/o Prem Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 08 weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.
