KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. The grievance which propelled the petitioner to file the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C, is the delay in deciding his private complaint No.1489 of 2020, which is pending adjudication before the learned trial Court concerned, since 2020. Through the instant petition, the petitioner by invoking the inherent powers of this Court, seeks directions upon the learned trial Court concerned, to make efforts, to decide the case in a time bound manner.
2. A perusal of the zimni orders, as annexed with this petition, it transpires that no effective hearing was carried out before the learned trial Court concerned.
3. Though an *innocuous* and *bona fide* prayer has been made by learned

counsel for the petitioner, for the speedy disposal of the private complaint, but this Court refrain to pass any specific time, for deciding the same, as this Court is not away about the docket of that Court. However, considering the *innocuous* and *bona fide* prayer, this Court directs the learned trial Court concerned, to make all efforts to decide the complaint No.1489 of 2020, most expeditiously.

4. The instant petition is **disposed** of accordingly.
