1. The present petition has been filed for seeking appropriate directions to the respondent-State to conduct proper investigation into FIR No.142 dated 26.10.2022 registered under Section 323, 341, 506, 34 and 307 IPC read with Section 25 Arms Act (added later on) registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.
2. After arguing on the merits of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all his contentions be kept open as he wishes to approach the Court of appropriate jurisdiction including to invoke the provisions under Section 156 Cr.P.C.
3. In light of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
