1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying order dated 11.05.2023, passed by this Court in CWP No. 271-2020 titled as '*Om Parkash vs State of Haryana and others*'.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that all the necessary benefits qua counting of service towards pensionary benefits, as ordered by the writ Court, has already been granted in favour of the petitioner and his case has been sent to the Accountant General, Haryana for further necessary action in the matter. However, the Accountant General, Haryana is not a party to the present petition.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
4. However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
