GURVINDER SINGH GILL.J (Oral)

1. Petitioner-Pawan Arora @ Monu has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.297, dated 27.8.2018 Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana, under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC (Section 411 IPC added later on), and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 30.05.2023, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

3. Report of learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statement of petitioner/accused Pawan Arora @ Monu, complainant Paramjit Singh and witness Rupinder Kaur have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. Complainant Paramjit Singh in his statement had stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.

5. The learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in **2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab**, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.297, dated 27.8.2018 Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana, under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC (Section 411 IPC added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
