VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed seeking a relief which would not ordinarily fall within the domain of a writ jurisdiction for being considered and for being granted.
2. Accordingly, this Court requests Mr. Manish Jain, Advocate, to render legal assistance to the petitioners, who is a senior citizen, so as to put his case within the domain of parameters that can be considered.
3. Mr. Manish Jain, Advocate, while appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that notwithstanding the scope of the writ petition, he would be satisfied if the pending representation dated 15.07.2022 (Annexure P-35) of the petitioners be decided by a competent authority for settlement of his dispute with the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited in terms of



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the Litigation Policy adopted by the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited.

- 4. Notice of motion.
- 5. Ms. Harpriya Khaneka, DAG Punjab, enters appearance for respondent-State and Mr. Nikhil Vats, Advocate, enters appearance and files memorandum of appearance on behalf of the respondents-PSPCL and submit that they have no objection to the aforesaid prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners. The memorandum of appearance is taken on record.
- 6. Consequently, the present writ petition is disposed of at this juncture with a direction to the respondents to take a considered decision on the representation dated 15.07.2022 (Annexure P-35) submitted by the petitioners to the Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd.
- 7. Let a decision on the said representation be taken by the competent authority pragmatically within a period of 04 months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order, after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties in accordance with law.
- 8. Needless to mention that the above said direction is without prejudice to *inter se* rights and objections of the respective parties.
- 9. All other civil misc. applications, if any, stands disposed of.
