The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.102 dated 19.03.2024 under Sections 21(b), 27-A NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.04.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 20.04.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
