1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that most of the relief claimed has already been sanctioned by the respondents and the grievance which survives is with regard to the grant of interest on the arrears of pension, which were paid to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that even the non-release of the ACP is still to be decided by the respondents hence, liberty be given to the petitioner to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation on the above said claim and the respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation/claim is received at the hands of the petitioner, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation/claim by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file appropriate representation with the respondents.

5. Ordered accordingly.
