1. Prayer in the present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking quashing of FIR No. 479 dated 11.08.2018, under Sections 354-A, 506 and 509 of IPC, and under Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Hissar Civil Lines, District Hissar.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent-State informs that the challan in the present matter was filed on 22.04.2018; charges were framed on 28.01.2021; and out of twelve witnesses, seven witnesses already stands examined. It is submitted that therefore, trial is at its fag end, and nothing survives in the matter.
