RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 07.03.2022 passed in CWP-4356-2022.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Gurbir Singh Dhillon, PCS-I, Deputy Registrar Cooperative Societies, Mohali, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Mr. Harbans Lal Sharma, Advocate, puts in appearance and files his power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.4, which is taken on record.
4. Counsel for the State submits that the order dated 07.03.2022 passed in CWP-4356-2022 has been complied with and speaking order (Annexure R-2/1) has been passed.
5. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
6. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
7. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the concerned authority.
