1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.288 dated 08.12.2017 registered under Sections 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Chheharta, alongwith all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including orders dated 03.05.2023 passed by learned JMIC, Amritsar and 16.09.2023, whereby, petitioners No.1 and 2 have been declared proclaimed offenders, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. On 24.04.2024, learned counsel for the petitioners withdrew his prayer qua quashing of the FIR detailed above and then prayer of the petitioners qua quashing of order dated 03.05.2023 (Annexure P-8) qua peitioner No.1 and order dated 16.09.2023 (Annexure P-10) qua petitioner No.2, who were declared proclaimed offenders, remains to be answered.

3. Learned State counsel has placed on record the status report by way of affidavit of Surinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central Amritsar, wherein, it has been mentioned that petitioners No.1 and 2

have already joined the investigation and as such the present petition be disposed of as infructuous.

4. In view of the above, when petitioners No.1 and 2 have joined the proceedings, the order dated 03.05.2023 (Annexure P-8) and 16.09.2023 (Annexure P-10) are hereby quashed and the present petition is disposed of.

5. Petitioners No.1 and 2 are directed to appear regularly before the trial Court as per its direction and abide by the terms and conditions of the bail, if any imposed by the trial Court.
