1. Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside impugned orders dated 13.04.2023, 10.01.2024 and 08.02.2024 passed by learned Debt Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh (for short 'DRT-II') in SA No. 78 of 2023.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he has instructions not to press this writ petition, at this stage. However, it is prayed that learned DRT-II, Chandigarh be directed to decide SA No. 78 of 2023 which is listed for final disposal on 13.06.2024 in a time bound manner. Entire proceedings are complete and matter it is reiterated is listed for final disposal on the said date. It is further prayed that liberty be afforded to petitioner to avail remedy(ies) available to him in accordance with law in respect to his grievance qua impugned orders, if so advised.

3. Writ petition is accordingly dismissed as not pressed with liberty to petitioner to avail remedy(ies) as may be available to him in accordance with law. Needless to say, it is expected that learned Tribunal

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would dispose of SA No. 78 of 2023 expeditiously, keeping in view the specific mandate, letter and spirit of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 itself.
