This regular second appeal has been filed by the appellant-Lakha Singh praying for setting aside the judgment dated 25.09.2000 passed by the District Judge, Ferozepur whereby order dated 01.06.1998 passed by the Civil Judge, (Jr. Division), Zira decreeing the suit of the plaintiff for recovery of Rs. 45,000/- has been set aside.
