1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 12.01.2023 passed in CWP-521-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of short affidavit of the respondent filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent has submitted that claim of the petitioner made in the writ petition was itself qua the grant of dearness allowance w.e.f. 01.07.2015 to 31.12.2015. The said benefit has already been extended to the petitioners. Copy of the letter to this effect has also been placed on record.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-



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redressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
