Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by an office order dated 28.03.2024 (Annexure P/2), a punishment of recovery has been imposed upon the petitioner and as the said order was causing prejudice to the petitioner, the petitioner has filed an appeal (Annexure P/3) before the higher authorities.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that on the one hand, the said appeal (Annexure P/3) is not being decided by the authority concerned and on the other hand, recovery has been started, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner hence, the respondents may kindly be directed to decide the said appeal in a time bound manner.

authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
