HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. By this common order, two Regular Second Appeals, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as both the appeals involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in the suit filed, the appellant was claiming promotion to the post of Sub Station Attendant retrospectively w.e.f. 02.03.2004, which claim has been denied by both the Courts below. Learned counsel for the appellant further submits that as per the settled principle of law, once the appellant has worked on current duty charge on the post of Sub Station Attendant, he is entitled for the salary for

the said post hence, the present appeals may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the appellant to avail appropriate remedy to claim the salary for the period the appellant had discharged the duties of the post of Sub Station Attendant on current duty charge.

3. Ordered accordingly.
