AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners Rajni Bala and Sukhchain Singh have filed criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent No.4 and not to interfere in their life and liberty.

2. It was alleged that both petitioners were in live-in-relationship. Respondent No.4 is the husband of petitioner No.1-Rajni Bala. Out of this wedlock, they had a girl child who is residing with her father. Similarly, petitioner No.2-Sukhchain Singh is also married to Manpreet Kaur on 13.10.2011 and out of this wedlock, there is a girl child who is staying with her mother. Thereafter, both petitioners came in contact with each other and they started living in live-in relationship.

3. Notice was issued for 26.04.2024. Status report has been received. As per the status report, statements of petitioner No.2- Sukhchain Singh and his mother Sawinder Kaur have been recorded, where they have

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confirmed that Petitioner No.1-Rajni Bala has returned back to her husband Manjit Kumar-respondent No.4. Copies of their statements are Annexure R-1/T and R-2/T.

4. Learned counsel for petitioner prayed that this petition be disposed of in view of status report.

5. I have gone through the contents of status report. As per the status report, petitioner No.1 has gone back to her husband-respondent No.4. This fact is also confirmed by petitioner No.2 and his mother. Therefore, present petition stands disposed having rendered infructuous.

6.. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
