In the present petition, grievance is being raised by the widow for the grant of compassionate appointment after the death of her husband, who unfortunately died on 15.12.2021 while working as Mali-cum-Chowkidar with the respondent-department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the instructions issued by the Government of Punjab, the petitioner being a widow of the deceased employee is entitled for the grant of benefit of compassionate appointment and hence, the respondents may kindly be directed to consider the claim of the petitioner for the grant of benefit of compassionate appointment as the petitioner is suffering and is not able to maintain herself as well as her two minor children.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of

submitting a representation dated 05.02.2024 (Annexure P/7), which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amar Preet Singh Bains, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, representation dated 05.02.2024 (Annexure P/7) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to her otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
