1. In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that despite the fact that he is working as Computer Operator with respondent No. 4 but he is not being paid the salary on the ground that the mode of payment of salary is to be decided.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the letter dated 07.03.2024 (Annexure P9) written by Deputy Conservator of Forest, Sonapat, appropriate instructions have been sought from the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Haryana for the release of the salary amounting to ₹2,08,000/-. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that once the petitioner is working, he is entitled for salary, which is being denied, which act on the part of the respondents is arbitrary and illegal.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that appropriate decision on the letter dated 07.03.2024 (Annexure P-9) will be taken within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and whatever amount, the petitioner is entitled for keeping in view the discharge of duties, the same will be released to him within a further period of two weeks.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.
7. Ordered accordingly.
