MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution has been filed for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect life & liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

2. Contends that private respondents are harassing the petitioners on false allegations that *khasra girdavri* of damaged crops under their possession has been transferred by the petitioners in their own names and an amount of Rs.40,000/- received from the authorities as compensation was usurped by them. Further contended petitioner No.1 was given beatings by the private respondents in the Police Station, Guhla, in presence of respondent Nos.2 & 3. Again submitted that on 16.04.2024, petitioners have already moved a representation before respondent No.2, but no action has been taken so far. Lastly submitted that petitioner No.3 is in advance stage of pregnancy, but the private respondents are threatening them to vacate their house immediately.

4. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the paper-book.
5. Concededly, both sides, i.e. petitioners as well as respondent Nos.4 to 6 are co-sharers and as such, *prima facie*, a civil dispute is being given the colour of criminal proceedings.
6. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present petition at this stage.
7. Ordered accordingly.
8. However, petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
9. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
